Aberdein Considine Open – Sunday 7th June 2009 9-Hole Flag Competition

- 1 The competition will be a Flag Competition played over Alford golf course. Open to any club / child that is now part of Clubgolf coaching programme.
- 2 There will be three boys' sections and three girls' sections relating to the following age groups 7-8 years, 9-10 years, and 11-12 years.
- 3 Each competitor shall have 36 shots only, and shall place their flag where their final shot came to rest. The winner in each category shall be the competitor whose ball is in, or is nearest, the hole after his or her 36th stroke. Should the resting position of the player's 36th shot be indeterminable the flag will be placed at the point where the ball was last struck.
- 4 In the event of a tie for 1st place in any of the sections there will be a three stroke play-off starting from the first tee. The winner shall be the competitor whose ball is in, or is nearest, the hole after his or her third stroke.
- 5 The tournament will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as Approved by R&A Rules Limited, additional Flag Golf rules as follow and in accordance with the Local Rules of the golf course.
- 6 No caddies are allowed.
- 7 No advice may be given on the course. Breach of this rule will result in the competitor being penalised by adding on 2 strokes in the first instance and a subsequent breach will result in the competitor being disqualified.
- 8 All competitors will play from the same tees.
- 9 Not more than 10 strokes in total may be taken at any hole, including a maximum of 4 putts on any green. If a competitor reaches the maximum number of strokes or putts for that hole they will record their score and progress to the next hole. The competitor can continue to play providing they have not exceeded their 36 shots.
- 10 After three failed attempts to play from a bunker, a competitor may throw his or her ball nearer the hole for no penalty, but only the three failed strokes will count.
- 11 Flags of other competitors that interfere with play may be marked, removed and replaced by the supervisor.
- 12 On the completion of each hole, supervisors should agree the score with each of the other supervisors and players and record it on the score card.
- 13 The Organising Committee reserves the right to amend the conditions and the decision of the committee will be final, in all matters.

Aberdein Considine Open – Sunday 7th June 2009 9-Hole Flag Competition – Conditions – Boys and Girls

- 1 The competition shall be open to boys and girls aged 7 years to 12 years on 1st January 2009.
- 2 A parent, or another adult (over 18) nominated by the parent, must supervise each child on the course. A supervisor does not require a full knowledge of the Rules of Golf, but some knowledge would be helpful. The role is chiefly to keep the player's score and to supervise their behaviour on the course.
- 3 Competitors must return their completed **entry form and entry fee to Junior Flag Competition, Alford Golf Club, Montgarrie Road, Alford, AB33 8AE**, not later than 12 noon on 30th May 2009. Entries will close at this time or when the limit is reached whichever is soonest.
- 4 The Organising Committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
- 5 The entry fee shall be £3.00, the fee includes green fees. All cheques/ postal orders should be made payable to Alford Golf Club.
- 6 The draw will be posted on the Junior Golf page of the Alford Golf Club website <http://www.alford-golf-club.co.uk/> from 30thnd May 2009.
- 7 Competitors should register at Alford Golf Club at least 30 minutes before their tee time and be on the first tee 10 minutes before their tee time.
- 8 The prize list will be announced on the day of the competition.
